We urge all the schools and preschools to consider these admissions as a special case and accept the child without a valid leaving certificate so that the children don't have to bear the brunt of this unfortunate development.

5-point recommendations to parents when choosing a preschool for your child-

1. Preschool learning is not an expense but an investment that you are making for the future life skills and learning foundation of your child. So cheap is not necessarily the best and expensive is not necessarily the right choice. Choose wisely.
2. Check the credentials of the person running the preschool/brand.
3. What is their credibility to be an early childhood educator?
4. Do not choose a school based on their ads or the 'brandedness'. Trust word on mouth more than fancy ads.
5. Do not trust schools that treat their fees as a discount festival! A discounted fee leads to discounted quality.

Recommendations to ECA member preschools-

1. Please help accommodate Tree house parents if they approach you.
2. Try and offer them a support in the fees charged if possible.
