Why we started the initiative?

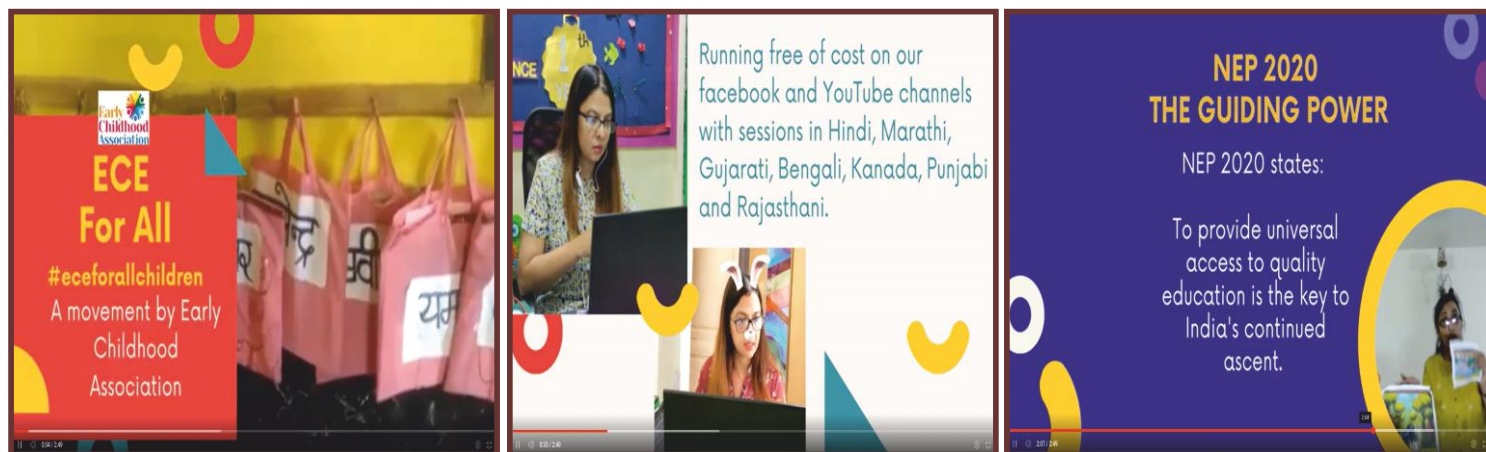

a. #eceforsallchildren

For over a year, children did not have any access to early childhood education which could have affected the very foundation of language, numeracy, emotional and social learning and meant suboptimal utilization of the brain development years. #eceforsallchildren was a key initiative by the ECA-APER to ensure children have had access to online sessions conducted through Facebook and YouTube channels - for children in the age group of 3 to 6 years, the brain development years - to bridge the divide between those that could not get access to education through free sessions.

Starting July 2020, free sessions provided lessons and activities to engage children through music and movement, rhyme time, stories in Hindi, Marathi, Gujarati, Bengali, Kanada, Punjabi and Rajasthani that helped them understand feelings, hygiene, health, eating habits and much more. Children from Anganwadis and Balwadis were encouraged to participate through NGOs. Teachers and parents also benefited through weekly sessions on engaging with children, managing their behaviour, making simple aids, puppetry, improving listening skills and using simple materials available at home to encourage life skills in children.

HERE ARE SOME IMPORTANT POINTS FROM UNICEF ON HOW TO TALK TO CHILDREN ABOUT COVID-19

- 1. Ask open questions and listen**
Start by inviting your child to talk about the issue. Find out how much they already know and follow their lead. If they are particularly young and haven't already heard about the outbreak, you may not need to raise the issue - just take the chance to remind them about good hygiene practices without introducing new fears.
Make sure you are in a safe environment and allow your child to talk freely. Drawing, stories and other activities may help to open up a discussion.
Most importantly, don't minimize or avoid their concerns. Be sure to acknowledge their feelings and assure them that it's natural to feel scared about these things. Demonstrate that you're listening by giving them your full attention, and make sure they understand that they can talk to you and their teachers whenever they like.
- 2. Be honest - explain the truth in a child-friendly way**
Children have a right to truthful information about what's going on in the world, but adults also have a responsibility to keep them safe from distress. Use age-appropriate language, watch their reactions, and be sensitive to their level of anxiety. If you can't answer their questions, don't guess. Explain that some information online isn't accurate, and that it's best to trust the experts.
- 3. Show them how to protect themselves and their friends**
One of the best ways to keep children safe from coronavirus and other diseases is to simply encourage regular handwashing. It doesn't need to be a scary conversation. You can also show children how to cover a cough or a sneeze with their elbow, explain that it's best not to get too close to people who have these symptoms, and ask them to tell you if they start to feel like they have a fever, cough or are having difficulty breathing.
- 4. Offer reassurance**
When we're seeing lots of troubling images on TV or online, it can sometimes feel like the crisis is all around us. Children may not distinguish between images on screen and their own personal reality, and they may believe they're in imminent danger. You can help your children cope with the stress by making opportunities for them to play and relax, when possible. Keep regular routines and schedules as much as possible, especially before they go to sleep, or help create new ones in a new environment. If you are experiencing an outbreak in your area, remind your children that lots of adults are working hard to keep your family safe. If your child does feel unwell, explain that they have to stay at home at the hospital because it is safer for them and their friends. Reassure them that you know it is hard (maybe scary or even boring) at times, but that following the rules will help keep everyone safe.
- 5. Check if they are experiencing or spreading stigma**
The outbreak of coronavirus has brought with it numerous reports of racial discrimination around the world, so it's important to check that your children are neither experiencing nor contributing to bullying. Explain that coronavirus has nothing to do with what someone looks like, where they are from or what language they speak.
- 6. Look for the helpers**
It's important for children to know that people are helping each other with acts of kindness and generosity. Share stories of health workers, scientists and young people, among others, who are working to stop the outbreak and keep the community safe. It can be a big comfort to know that compassionate people are taking action.
- 7. Take care of yourself**
You'll be able to help your kids better if you're coping, too. Children will pick up on your own moods and feelings. If you're feeling anxious or upset, take time for yourself and reach out to other family members and trusted people in your community. Make some time to do things that help you relax and reenergize.
- 8. Close conversations with care**
It's important to know that we're leaving children in a state of distress. As your conversation wraps up, try to gauge their level of anxiety by watching their body language, considering whether they're using their usual tone of voice and watching their breathing. Remind your children that they can have other difficult conversations with you at any time. Remind them that you care, you're listening and that you're available whenever they're feeling worried.

Here are some Do's and Don'ts from UNICEF for educators and media on HOW TO TALK ABOUT THE CORONAVIRUS

DO: Talk about the new coronavirus disease (COVID-19)

DON'T: Attach locations or ethnicity to the disease. Remember, viruses can't target people from specific populations, ethnicities, or racial backgrounds.

DO: Talk about "people who have COVID-19", "people who are being treated for COVID-19", "people who are recovering from COVID-19" or "people who died after contracting COVID-19"

DON'T: refer to people with the disease as "COVID-19 cases" or "victims"

DO: Talk about people "acquiring" or "contracting" COVID-19

DON'T: Talk about people "transmitting COVID-19" "infecting others" or "spreading the virus" as it implies intentional transmission and assigns blame.

DO: Speak accurately about the risk from COVID-19, based on scientific data and latest official health advice

DON'T: Repeat or share unconfirmed rumours, and avoid using hyperbolic language designed to generate fear like "plague", "apocalypse" etc.

DO: Talk positively and emphasise the importance of effective prevention measures, including following tips on handwashing and social distancing.

Think of its negative impact on children before taking such decisions. ECA has highlighted some incorrect practices and suggested some solutions to use instead.

Bridge Courses

Bridge Courses- These are 2-3 month courses started by many preschools. These courses are offered to parents to help their child complete the last year's 'portion'! So if a child has not attended virtual preschool last year, then the child would be 'helped' to complete last year's 'portion' in 2-3 months so that the child can be admitted to the next class.

Why is this bad for children?

This is extremely stressful for children as children have to 'fast forward' through a whole year's curriculum in 2-3 months. Does this even require further explanation? True early childhood educators would know that this is a highly detrimental idea.

Why is it bad for preschools?

It is also detrimental to the concept of preschool- parents will wonder that if you are able to complete a whole year's portion in 2-3 months, virtually, then why would I want to send my child for the full year?

Solution- Keep a bridge class every Friday and Saturday (for the entire year) in which you can help the children understand the concept that is linked to the next week's curriculum. So that those that have missed last year can still be part of this year's class and get weekly support from you to help understand the concepts they missed before they are introduced to the next linked concepts.

Shifting virtual classes to evening slot

Shifting virtual classes to evening slot - Many preschools are 'adjusting' to the requirement of working parents and changing their preschool time to evening slots for preschoolers. Shouldn't the corporates or offices where these parents work adjust for the children? Isn't it sad that we are adjusting for 'adults' and not for our youngest children?

Why is it bad for children?

Evening is good for some older children but young children are most active in the mornings and early afternoon, then many of them have nap habits and like to play and wind down for bedtime. If virtual learning is going to be after 4pm, it would mean that children are going to be experiencing 'screen time' learning more closer to their end of day activities. Also, when physical school reopens soon, these children will find it difficult to adjust to the change in timing from evening learning to morning learning.

Why is it bad for preschools?

Preschools are advocates for child rights and during the pandemic if preschools are going to keep parental needs above those of young children, then who will be the voice for children? Ideally it is the youngest child for whom families should be making adjustments and not the other way around.

Solution- Preschoolers can have their sessions anytime upto 2 in the afternoon. Avoid having virtual sessions later than 2pm.

Early Childhood Association understands that preschools are going through a financial crunch and finding it difficult to survive. But is surviving at the cost of developmental appropriateness the right solution?

Sending a teacher home to a child's house

Sending a teacher home to a child's house- Many preschools are sending a teacher to each child's house. Sounds good but it turns out to be more like a 'tutor' session of worksheets and books!

Why is it bad for children?

Children don't need the pressure of 'learning' through worksheets etc. in this pandemic. They need to hear and see their peer group and enjoy an hour of being a part of a group, even if virtually at present.

Why is it bad for preschools?

Aren't you reducing the respect of a preschool teacher by making her into a 'tutor' teacher? How helpful is it for a child to only interact with an adult through worksheets and forced learning?

Solution- Send an ayah or helper staff home who will sit with the child during the virtual class. Sometimes parents don't have the time to sit with the children as they are busy with another child or their office work. This way the problem of the parents will be solved and the child will get the necessary support and be part of the virtual program with his/her peers.

32% PARENTS WON'T SEND KIDS TO SCHOOL

Survey shows despite pandemic waning, issues like lack of kiddie vax, continuing WFH regimes mean parents aren't ready even if kids are!

THE COVID-19 pandemic has created a whole new set of woes, the anxiety of young parents to let their children attend school physically is one of them. Although the number of COVID-19 cases in the city has decreased significantly and it has been over two months since schools across the state reopened, a survey of 7,665 parents of pre-primary and primary students has revealed that nearly 32 per cent of them are still unwilling to send their children to a physical school. ■ P02

Fathers keen on sending children to school, but mothers still hesitant

The government recently released a circular regarding physical presence of schools and the start of the academic year. One of the points that joined all schools was the government directive not to hold online education for pre-school to grade 2. It came as a jolt to most schools as many start their academic year in April and had already started their online platforms and had completed one month of the academic year. We understand that the government has taken this stand keeping in mind the physical and mental health of children, but there should be more clarity on this as WHO and American Academy of Paediatricians say that one hour of video class for children above the age of 3 years. So we feel that instead of a blanket ban that is going to bring its own issues, it would have been better if guidelines had been defined by the government regarding online education for pre-school to grade 2.

Some schools have filed a PIL, some have started protests and some have just continued the online education. Some parents are in support of online education as their child's school was conducting age appropriate sessions that were beneficial to the child. Some parents are happy with the ban as their child's school was not doing anything, or was doing too much and pressuring the child and the family.

How will this impact children is the question we should be asking ourselves. The government circular says that children should watch educational content on television and/or radio. But is this content available in regional languages and in English for our anganwadis, government and private schools? Because this is the specific requirement that parents go for. If half hour-one hour of television viewing is not harmful then why not change the guidelines to allow half hour-one hour of online education? Brain research clearly states that one-way screen viewing is more harmful than an interactive screen viewing like a video or online chat with a teacher.

The circular says Children of classes one and two should study at home till offline classes are started. So how do they study? Parents have no time or ability to teach them so naturally private companies have been offering on the content to children, and parents first enrolled free for these platforms and now these platforms are charging anywhere around 2800 and more. So we are saying that private companies can enrol children for online education

but schools cannot? Who is more qualified here to give online education to children? We urge the government to ban all kinds of online learning platforms for children in preschool to grade 2 as it is not fair that the private players are driving out quality schools from educating children already enrolled with them.

It's a vicious cycle. Parents will not pay fees till there are no online classes, schools cannot have online classes so no fees- no fees so teacher salaries cannot be paid- so teachers are forced to take tuition tuitions! So whichever way one looks at it, online is still on, it is just banned for school!

If you read the circular there is a point 7, it says online education should be planned so that students education is not disrupted in case a child is covid positive or the school has to be shut down again. It means that online and offline will be required this year, so then would it not make more sense to ensure that children settle into this new normal from the beginning?

If we study what schools around the globe are doing, all of them have an online and offline model or as called asynchronous and synchronous model. So that children adjust faster to the new type of schooling and there is no break in their learning. With online banned for preschool to grade 2 that will happen in their learning in this interim period? It will lead to learning lags and when will they cope once school is opened? It will put huge amount of pressure on children and there is no content meant for the year in a few months. By doing this we are not only increasing the pressure of learning on children but also leading to weak foundation of learning. Some people also say that maybe there will be children's education system in a huge crisis and the ones to be the most affected by it will be our children.

Post lockdown, kids get upset even when pencil point breaks

They can't wait for their turn, don't want to share, and need constant reminders to finish their work: Survey reveals children are struggling at school, and so are teachers

ONLINE classes may have emerged as a saviour during the lockdown, but the transition back to traditional or hybrid schooling is proving to be a challenge for teachers and students. A survey conducted by the Early Childhood Association (ECA) and the Association for Primary Education and Research (APER) revealed behavioural and learning issues in children in early and primary school, while transitioning from online to offline classes.

According to the survey, 31 per cent of all teachers interviewed said their students are unable to participate in collaborative activities, and 36 per cent said their students are apologetic and anxious about every-day learning activities. Teachers also reported that the students were not able to follow instructions. Some want to talk to their parents during class because they are new or confused to be with them. They also require constant reminders to finish their work and do not wait for their turn, and so are teachers.

"During most of the online period, we engaged children in discussing classroom rules, playing and talking, making them comfortable in their own space, being flexible with the use of language, developing routines, and making them feel welcome."

"We are offering a lot of support to children who are struggling to adjust to the offline mode of learning. We are well-equipped by parents, because it allows children to grow with with dual benefits."

According to the survey, 31 per cent of all teachers interviewed said their students are unable to participate in collaborative activities, and 36 per cent said their students are apologetic and anxious about every-day learning activities. Teachers also reported that the students were not able to follow instructions. Some want to talk to their parents during class because they are new or confused to be with them. They also require constant reminders to finish their work and do not wait for their turn, and so are teachers.

They are finding it extremely difficult to adjust to rules and discipline. Teachers stated that sharing, waiting for their turn, and waiting until a story or worksheet is finished is not easy for many children. This means that implicit curriculum and social skills are lacking. Being angry is another common behaviour in children who are used to online learning, where they get instant feedback and so are teachers.

Schools get guidelines for kids' safety post-lockdown

Mumbai: Schools are worried that parents will be anxious about their children's safety, once lockdown is lifted and they go back to classrooms. To help schools tide over the change, the Early Childhood Association (ECA) and the Association for Primary Education and Research (APER) drafted a set of guidelines that could be followed. The 54-page document lists precautions that schools can take in classrooms and on their premises, during bus travel, sanitation and documentation. The associations suggested that schools re-open in a staggered manner, giving small batches a chance to settle in. They also suggested that each school have a safety coordinator to ensure the implementation of safety procedures and guidelines.

"Cancel all group events and open house, conduct it virtually with each parent. If you have children with underlying health conditions and children with disabilities, talk to their parents about the risks and how their children can continue to receive the support they need," said the document. ■■

MAJOR AREA OF CONCERN IN ECE

Policy documents such as RTE 2009, National ECCE Policy 2013, and NEP 2020 have emphasized that children should participate in a preschool or Anganwadi from age 3 to 6 years, after which point, they should enter Grade 1 of primary schools.

NEP 2020 states that the Foundational Stage begins at Age 3 and ends at Age 8 i.e., five years of schooling from preschool to Grade 2. Children should, therefore, begin Grade 1 at the age of 6 years. However, many State policies do not reflect these age and developmental milestones.

Given the rapid pace of brain growth, and overall development of the child in the early years, a difference of even a few months is significant. The curriculum for Grade 1 is designed with the assumption that children will be over 6 years old.

The trend of officially advancing the entry age for Grade 1 to below 6 years defies this assumption and can pose significant damage to children's cumulative learning

But some states and union territories are still not adhering to this and children as young as 2.5 years are joining nursery class and are doing a curriculum meant for three year old's. This is an area of concern and needs to be rectified immediately.

ECA-APER have been consistently campaigning in all states with our campaign #Nursery@3 to ensure that parents, educators and policy makers become aware of the urgent need for the same.

ECA-APER are taking up this issue strongly with the central government as children in every state of India need developmentally appropriate age entry. When the country is moving towards a common civil code then a common age criterion for school entry is also a must.

This is the data of the states we have, those who are following the entry age of 3 years and those who have yet to change their policy-
