



1. Healthy Food Campaign

Children continue to consume excessive junk food, and many parents and schools remain unaware of its impact or the nutritional value of the food they provide. To address this concern, ECA-APER initiated the Healthy Food Campaign, spreading awareness and encouraging healthier food choices.

Building on last year's success, we continued our campaign this year with the hashtags #BeWiseChooseRight and #SayNoToJunk. The campaign has now reached 500+ schools and 100,000+ parents, making them more mindful of the importance of balanced nutrition in children's daily diets.





As part of this initiative, ECA-APER President Dr. Swati Popat Vats wrote a letter to Shri Rohit Kumar Singh, Secretary of the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food, and Public Distribution, appealing for the creation of regulatory guidelines to control the levels of salt, sugar, and fat in foods consumed by children from various companies and restaurants. In response, we received a reply from Dr. Kavitha Ramaamy, Joint Director (Science & Standards).

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We collaborated with Vigour360 to raise awareness about nutritious eating habits in schools and homes. To support this initiative, we conducted a live webinar featuring experts who shared valuable insights on fostering a healthier lifestyle. Additionally, we organized a panel discussion on 'Eat Wise, Choose Right' on 16th May, highlighting the importance of mindful eating and informed food choices. Through these initiatives, we have taken significant steps to encourage children, parents, and educators to prioritize healthy eating habits.







2. #Kuch Asli Meetha Ho! Campaign

As part of our Healthy Food Campaign, for the Diwali festival, we encouraged families to choose homemade ghee mithai over factory-made chocolates through our **#KuchAsliMeethaHo initiative**. The campaign emphasized the nutritional benefits of traditional sweets while raising awareness about the risks of processed chocolates, promoting mindful eating habits among children.










1. 'Dinosaurs Among Us' Exhibition
